### KEYNOTE SPEAKER

ADRIENNE BOISSY, MD, MA Friday, April 21, 2017 11:30 am - 12:30 pm



Adrienne Boissy, MD, MA, is the chief experience officer of Cleveland Clinic. She is a staff physician at the Cleveland Clinic Mellen Center for Multiple Sclerosis and has a secondary appointment in Bioethics.

Dr. Boissy guided the development of patient advisory councils across the Cleveland Clinic Health System. She currently serves as editor in chief of the Journal of Patient Experience. As part of her clinical work, Dr. Boissy focuses on ethical issues in neurological disease. She served on the Cleveland Clinic Ethics Committee and is the assistant clinical director in the Center for Neuroethics. She has been published in Neurocritical Care, Continuum and Neurology regarding the humane treatment of critically ill patients and communication challenges in clinical practice. In particular, she has a special interest in the words clinicians choose when conveying information, and the risks and ethics of what she calls "therapeutic mislabeling" versus truth telling.

Dr. Boissy was awarded a Sylvia Lawry Fellowship grant from the National Multiple Sclerosis Society and an Arnold P. Gold Foundation grant for humanism in medicine. She also serves on the editorial board of the National Multiple Sclerosis Society's *Momentum* magazine. Dr. Boissy also is a Harvard Macy scholar. She has spoken extensively around the country about the patient and provider experience and the impact of effective communication on both.

Joselin Linder is a regular contributor to the *New York Post*, whose work has also been featured on *This American Life*, *Morning Edition* and *Life of the Law*. A Columbus, Ohio, native, she now lives in Brooklyn with her husband and two dogs. Joselin is the daughter of the late William Linder, DO, who practiced medicine at Doctors Hospital in Columbus.



#### ANDREA AMALFITANO, DO, PHD

Dr. Amalfitano is the Osteopathic Heritage Foundation Endowed Professor of Pediatrics, Microbiology and Molecular Genetics at Michigan State University. His expertise as both a clinician and scientist is particularly noteworthy. His work includes clinical and experimental genetics, immunology, and technology development for use in genetic diseases, cancer and infectious diseases. Dr. Amalfitano has served as principal investigator on projects ranging from basic investigations, preclinical studies and human clinical trails that led to the development of FDA-approved therapies.


