

Ohio Osteopathic Symposium Poster Competition and Exhibition Frequently Asked Questions

How many abstracts may I submit?

Each presenter can submit up to three abstracts for consideration.

Do I have to be in attendance to present my poster?

All posters must be accompanied by an author listed on the poster. Authors can present multiple posters and accommodations will be make in the judging schedule to allow authors to present multiple posters.

Is this poster competition open to only osteopathic (DO) students and residents?

The poster competition is open to both DO and MD students and residents from any residency program or college of medicine. This competition is not exclusive to the Heritage College or Ohio. DO and MD physicians, medical educators or others who are not student or residents are welcome to submit up to three abstracts for consideration for Exhibition, which are non-judged featured posters.

Am I permitted to present research that has been presented at another conference or published previously?

Please obtain permission from the publisher or previous conference organizer for permission to present the research at the Ohio Osteopathic Symposium. Upload written confirmation with your abstract into the online abstract submission system.

When will I be notified of my abstract acceptance?

All corresponding authors will be notified by February 28 if their abstract was accepted for presentation.

How much does it cost to participate in the poster competition?

Each corresponding author who has abstracts accepted for presentation will be asked to pay a \$25 fee to help offset the cost of the competition. The fee is assessed for each author, not the number of posters he or she is presenting. Each corresponding author who has accepted abstracts will receive notification on how and when to pay this fee.

How long do I have to be present to accompany my poster?

All posters will need to be displayed by 7:30 am on Saturday, April 25. Judging and general viewing is held between at 8 - 10:30 am. Presenting authors are expected to remain at their posters throughout this period. All posters may be removed by 10:30 am. Poster awards will be announced at noon.
