#### **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

The conference will provide the internist with a general review of all aspects and specialties in internal medicine. Medicine experts will provide comprehensive didactic sessions over a 5-day period on all general medicine and specialty subjects in internal medicine. During each lecture, a multiple choice question and answer session take place in an effort to simulate board examination. A live instantaneous audience response system will be used to collect and display participant answers to help facilitate areas for further discussion.
