INSTRUCTIONS & GUIDELINES

- ◆ All participants will be provided 4'x8' bulletin board on which to display their poster. Push-pins will be provided.
- ◆ Awards will consist of 1st (\$1,000) and 2nd (\$500) place prizes.

All posters will be judged on 6 required elements: 5 visual elements related to information presented on the poster and 1 element based on oral communication skills.

1. Title and Author(s)
The title should summarize the work and stimulate the viewer to read the poster. Names of the principal investigator and all co-authors should be indicated, along with respective affiliations.
2. Introduction
The introduction should clearly state the purpose and objectives of the project and should describe how it builds on existing work or findings.
3. Methodology
Methodology sections usually include of a brief description of the target sample, including sample size and demographics if relevant, general design of the study (retrospective chart review, experimental design, survey-based design, qualitative research, etc.), analyses conducted, statistical power and effect sizes, if relevant.
4. Results
Results must be clearly presented and appropriately summarized. Presenters are encouraged to incorporate tables, charts, graphs, and other visuals in their posters.
5. Conclusion
Conclusions must be based on study results and should emphasize the significance and implications of the study.
6. Communication
Participants will be expected to respond to questions and to clearly explain their projects.
